Directions for Service Project:

Every Parent is responsible for driving their child to and from the Service Project or arranging their own car pool. The class teacher is not allowed to drive the children because of Insurance reasons.

Please arrive 10 minutes before the scheduled start time and meet your teacher in the lobby at CROSS. Stephanie is our contact person at Cross Food. She is the Volunteer coordinator and can be reached at: 763-267-5182. The students will be excused at 8 pm on Thursday evenings, and Saturday morning at 11:00 am. Please arrive promptly for pick up.

Driving Directions to CROSS:

Take Highway 81 Northwest to County Road 13 (or Brocton). There is a stoplight at this intersection.

Turn Right.

Drive 1-1.5 miles to County Road 49.

Turn Left. (You will see a sign for Rogers that has an arrow pointing where you need to turn.)

Drive .25 miles to the parking lot, which will be on your right.

To Make-up your Service project:

Please make every effort to attend the scheduled service project for your child's class teacher listed on the other side. 1. You and your child are responsible for contacting another catechist by email from the list provided in order to request to attend the service project scheduled for that catechist.
2. You or your child must also tell your child's catechist which service project they are planning to attend.

IMPORTANT: If a child is dropped off without a signed consent form they will be asked to call their parents to return to sign the form or they will need to leave.

4. Obtain a completed Service Project Verification form (yellow) from the attending Teacher and return it to your class teacher.
