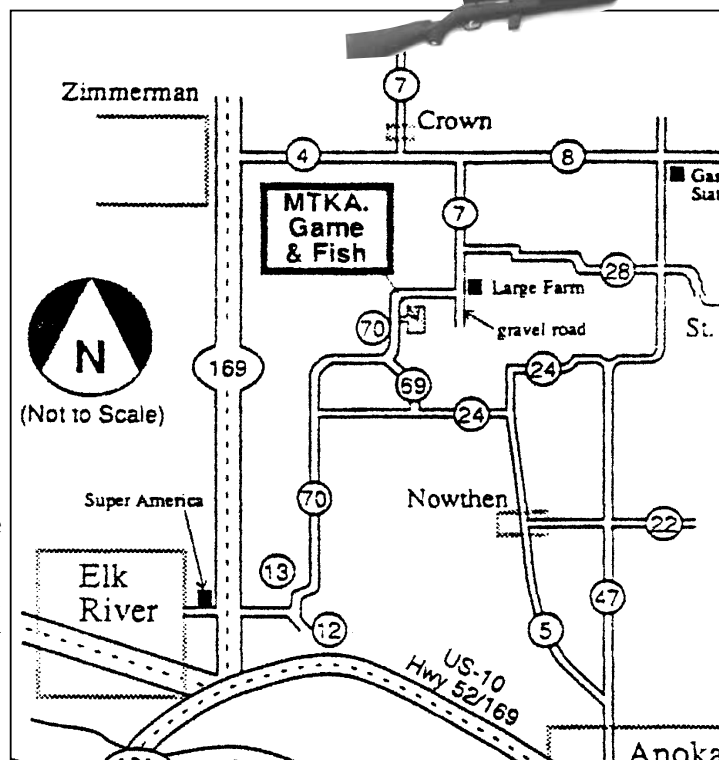

**40 Days for Life**

The Knights of Columbus, Council 9139 will sponsor a 16-hour prayer vigil at the Robbinsdale Family (Abortion) Clinic located at 3819 W. Broadway Ave., Robbinsdale, MN. Pro-Life Action Ministries is coordinating the effort for the Twin Cities and will run from September 24 through November 2, 2014.

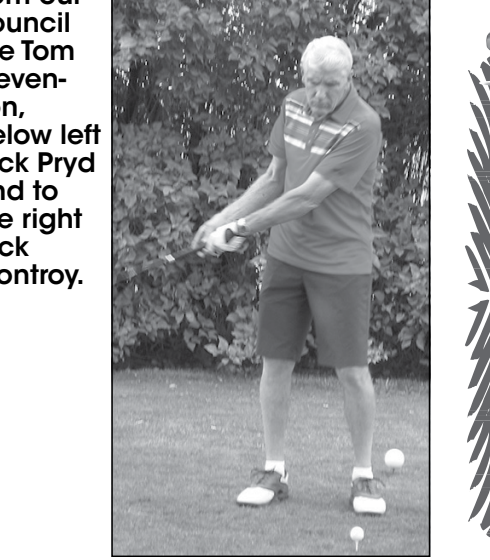
"40 Days for Life", founded by college students in 2007, is an international movement of prayer, fasting and peaceful vigils to access God's power to end abortions. The concept of "40 Days" is biblically based. Since its inception 625,000 individuals have participated in 539 cities and 24 countries. The results have been amazing with 8,973 babies saved, 54 abortion facilities have closed and 101 abortion employees have quit. In 2013 the Robbinsdale clinic performed 1,155 abortions.

Council 9139 will sponsor the prayer vigil on Saturday, October 11, 2014, from 6 a.m. to 10 p.m. consisting of eight 2-hour prayer periods for a total of 16 hours.

The prayer vigil is totally peaceful - no confrontations, no protests, etc. Bring a chair if you need one; bring your spouse; bring your family; bring a rosary. Prayer is our focus; God chooses the time to close an abortion site. We are looking for 8 vigil leaders and lots of prayer participants.
