Here's what you do.....

1. Go through your old or unwanted items from the approved list
2. Place any approved items into bags or boxes (however you can get it to SVDP)
3. Drop off October 20-24 (M-F) in the front entry way of the school. 7:00a.m.-2:30p.m.  
\*\*On Monday October 20 and Thursday, October 24, hours for drop off will be 7:00a.m. -8:00 p.m. (during conferences)
