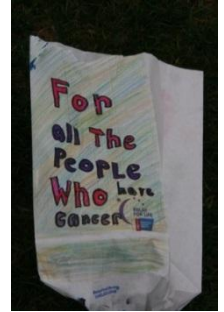

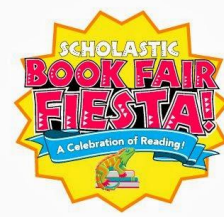

#### **Summer Book Club**

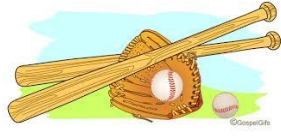
